From evidence about liability or breach, to the quantity of loss or damages, the resolution of maritime disputes makes significant use of expert evidence. There are guiding principles of cross-examination in international arbitration that must be grasped to gain mastery of the skill. This seminar seeks to refresh, reinforce and expand upon the tenets of cross-examinations. Barrister and Arbitrator, Mr. Greg Laughton SC, will discuss the need for and the general rules of cross-examination, including the methods, styles, and psychology. Attendees can also expect to learn about analysing expert evidence, preparing for cross-examination of experts, effectively cross-examining experts, and the different style needed when experts give evidence together, i.e., "hot-tubbing". The knowledge shared by Mr. Laughton SC should assist:

EXPERTS to understand how their evidence would be treated by the cross-examiner;

ADVOCATES to learn the fundamentals of how to effectively cross-examine witnesses, including experts; and

ARBITRATORS to understand how expert evidence is likely to be analysed, questioned, and used by parties.
