## DESCRIPTION

The SIArb-SCMA Maritime Arbitrator's Fellowship Course ("Course") will be offered by the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators ("SIArb") in conjunction with Singapore Chamber of Maritime Arbitration ("SCMA").

The Course will comprise SIArb's **Fellowship Assessment Course ("FAC")** which will be held in a hybrid format, and the SCMA's **Maritime Arbitrator Accreditation Programme** (**"MAAP")** which will be held in person.
