There is considerable local concern regarding this incident, particularly regarding the adequacy of regulation of "flag of convenience" vessels entering Australian waters.

The ongoing investigation of the Australian Transport Safety Bureau is focusing on:

- a. the actions of the Tycoon's master and crew and those of the port's operational staff;
- b. the failure of the port's permanent stern mooring arrangement and the design and maintenance of the mooring system;
- c. port operational procedures, guidelines and risk assessment;
- d. the condition of Tycoon and the adequacy of the ship's mooring equipment; and
- e. Tycoon's safety management system and other on board guidance material.
